2.2. Venue Overview

This two-day competition is open to swimmers with physical, intellectual and visual impairment (S1-S14) from Croatia and abroad.

3.4. Rules & regulations

The competition is held in accordance with the [World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations February 2026](#).

Swimmers who hold a WPS license are eligible for recognition of their results on the world rankings.

Domestic competitors must be registered with the Croatian Para Swimming Federation (HPPS).

By registering for the competition, clubs guarantee that all registered swimmers have a valid medical examination

Each club/team may register one male and one female team. A team may consist of up to ten (10) swimmers who will earn points for the team ranking.

Note: Clubs may also participate in the team ranking with a smaller number of competitors (less than 10). In this case, all registered swimmers within the team will be scored.

In the event of a larger number of registered competitors, additional swimmers will compete in the open category (MD) and their results will not be scored for the team ranking.

Each competitor may compete in a maximum of two (2) disciplines per program. The team standings are scored based on the results of a maximum of two (2) individual disciplines on Saturday and two (2) individual disciplines on Sunday, in both men's and women's competitions.

If a competitor competes in fewer than four (4) disciplines, only the disciplines in which he/she competed are scored. Relay races are not included in the team standings.

The order of registration determines the composition of the teams: the first ten (10) registered swimmers form the men's team, the next ten (10) registered swimmers form the women's team. All other registered competitors compete outside of the team standings.

3.5. Awards

Cups and medals are awarded to the teams that win the first three places in the men's and women's categories, separately for the 7th Croatian Team Championship and separately for the 7th Croatian Open Team Championship.

All participants in the competition will be awarded Certificates of participation.

4.3. Warm-up & Swim-down

During the competition the 25m pool will always be available for warm up and swim-down.

The SID will be placed near the swimming pool entrance. Only one person at a time is allowed at the SID.
